Students who did not pass the Psychology course need to re-take the 3 course credits either Introduction to Psychology I or Introduction to Psychology II course and cannot to count toward the minor regulation of 25 course credits.2. Students need not re-take any required course(s) of their home department that are listed in this course outline; such course(s) cannot be waived. The department chair will designate a relative course(s) to substitute for that.3. Students need to take at least 25 course credits, in which 9 required course credits and 6 electives for three groups course credits.	
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
