- 1. A minimum of 138 credits are required to graduate from this department.
- 2. For those who are to acquire certificate of counseling psychology upon their graduation, 12 credits from general elective courses and 15 credits from professional elective courses of counseling psychology are required.
- 3. For those who are to acquire certificate of Industrial/Organizational Psychology upon their graduation, 12 credits from general elective courses and 15 credits from professional elective courses of Industrial/Organizational Psychology are required.
- 4. Students who fulfill the requirements for curriculum of Counseling Psychology or Industrial/Organizational Psychology will be awarded the certificate for the respective academic areas.
- 5. A maximum of 12 credits for courses outside EPC department may be included in the minimum credits required for elective professional courses.
- 6. Additional course credits in general education may not be included in the total number of credits required for obtaining a Bachelor's degree.
- 7. Teacher education program may not be included in the total number of credits required for obtaining a Bachelor's degree.
- 8. The EPC department requires one year of practicum training, which counts to 3 credits.
- 9. The elective courses on this Course Outline may be counted toward total graduation credits by students who entered the university prior to the 2008-9 academic year.
